**【Second Term】 July 5<sup>th</sup> (Sat)~July 7<sup>th</sup> (Mon) 3 days** }

9:30a.m.-4:30p.m. (Lunch break from 12:30p.m. to 1:30p.m.)

You need not take both terms at once; it is possible to take only the first or second term (3 days). However, only those who have taken both terms (6-days) will receive a certificate.

◦Fee 1,000 yen(class materials fee)

◦Capacity 10 people

◦Note The following people will be given priority: those newly arriving to Japan, those who are unfamiliar with the Japanese language, and those who can attend all programs.

**Second term contents:** two forms of the copula (aru vs. Iru) • verb conjugation
