

## The 21<sup>st</sup> International Volunteer Work Camp in ASO Application Guidelines & Schedule

This event positions "international" and "volunteer" as key concepts in 21st-century education. It encourages high school students to take an interest in the various issues occurring both around them and in the world, to think about what they can do to help solve these problems, and to connect their thoughts to everyday actions. Since 2006, the camp has been held with the aim of fostering the "zest for life" in young people by having high school students form an executive committee to plan and run the camp themselves.

During the camp, high school students and international students discuss global issues by taking part in workshops divided thematically, which have been prepared under the guidance of special advisors and alumni of the previous camp editions, while also having an opportunity to learn from the local entrepreneurs and NPOs, which makes the camp a large scale event joined by 150 people in total.

In 2012, Japan Volunteer Learning Society has awarded the camp the Alec Dickson Award, an honor given for outstanding social learning practices. Over the years the camp has developed tremendously and today it is affectionately known by many as "Bora-can" (short for "Volunteer Camp").

The theme of this year's event is "Shall we act? We can do it♡ ~When we meet, we change. When we take action, we change even more~" We hope that through taking action and interacting with fellow participants the camp will provide new developments toward a brighter future!
