The number of consultations received at the Plaza in March was 52. Many of the consultations were related to "interpretation and translation", "immigration procedures" and "others".

Regarding interpretation and translation

- · Can you provide interpreting support for a child with foreign roots who is having difficulty communicating with his/her teacher and mother at the elementary school he/she attends?
- →Plaza's multilingual consultant was dispatched as an interpreter.

Regarding immigration procedure

- I am working under the status of "Technical". My child's status of residence is "Family Resident". The next time I apply for renewal, he/she will be over 20. Can we apply for "Family Residency" status? I also want to invite another child over 20 from my home country to Japan. Is it possible?
- I want to manage assets. Is there any problem with my status being a foreign nationality?
- I have "Education" status. I want to apply for permanent residency. What are the requirements for application?

- How can I invite my friend in Ukraine to Japan?
- →It is possible for an individual to act as an underwriter and call them over. However, please check with the department in charge of Ukraine at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. (As of March 2022)
