Before we know it, we started to hear the sound of cicadas, and the season has completely turned into summer. The rainy season is over and summer is finally in full swing. And July through August is an eventful time. Summer festivals and fireworks displays, which could not be held until last year due to the Covid-19, will be held for the first time in many years. Be careful of heat stroke and have a pleasant summer.

The Plaza received 88 consultations in June. We share some of them with advice from us.

Q: I came to Kumamoto on a short-stay visa. I am looking for a job. Can you introduce me? A: A temporary visitor visa does not allow you to work (including part-time work).

- Q: I quit my job at the end of May. My residence card expired at the same time, and I plan to get a new card in June. I also plan to start working in June. I have been covered by the National Health Insurance but it has expired and I do not have a new insurance card. I am not feeling well and want to go to a clinic, but I am not sure whether I should go or not because I do not have an insurance card. What should I do?
- A : We contacted the National Insurance Section of Kumamoto City. They can reissue the insurance card, but it must be done at the counter. In such cases, ID, employee release form, and an expired insurance card are required. If you go to a clinic today, you will pay the 100% fee, but if you bring your new insurance card at a later date, they will refund you 70% of the medical fee.
- Q: Regarding the priority support benefits for rising prices of electricity, gas and food (30,000 yen), am I eligible to receive them?
- A : There are conditions for who can receive this benefit. Click on the link below for more information.

- Q : Inquiry from a local government office. A foreign resident came to the counter to pick up a certificate of residence as a necessary document for renewal of his/her residence card. Please tell me to what extent the information on the certificate of residence is required.
- A : All information other than the my number and resident record code number must be listed.
- Q: I am a Japanese national university student. I am studying Japanese and foreign culture at university and would like to know more about German culture.
- A : There is a German consultation every Wednesday between 13:00 and 17:00. You can talk to a German consultant about German culture and other topics. (\*Please call the office to inquire as consultation dates may change due to sudden official business commitments.)

## July & August are <sup>r</sup>Summer water conservation focus months」

Kumamoto City is engaged in a citizen's movement to conserve water in order to protect precious groundwater. The campaign aims to reduce the amount of water used per person per day to 210 liters by the year 2024. Since water use increases especially in the summer, the months of July and August are designated as "Summer Water Conservation Priority Periods. The following actions can help conserve water:

- Do not leave water running when washing dishes, brushing teeth, showering, etc.
- Proper use of large and small levers when flushing toilets
- Do not fill the bathtub to overflowing, and use leftover water for washing clothes and cleaning the bathroom
- $\cdot$  Use a watering can or bucket to water plants and flowerpots

In addition, try not to waste water in your daily life. Groundwater is a limited resource. Let's protect this precious water together!
