PLAZA NEWSLETTER (July 2025) It is now June and the rainy season has started in Kumamoto. It has often been hot during the day but cool in the mornings and evenings. From now on, it will be a time of humidity and heat, and you may feel ill. Be aware of sudden heat and make an effort to hydrate frequently. In addition, heavy rainfall in a short period of time may cause sudden rise of rivers and landslides. It can also be a time of frequent weather changes, so be sure to check the weather forecast in advance and take the necessary precautions.

Now then, allow us to partially introduce the consultation details found in our plaza. We received 73 consultations in May and have shared below examples of questions and answers. Some content has been edited for privacy concerns.

Q: Please tell me about the residence card and passport procedures for my baby to be born in the future. (Husband: student, Wife: dependent status of residence)

- A: First, it is necessary to report the birth to the municipal office of the city, ward, town or village where you live within 14 days of the birth and obtain a "Birth registration certificate" for immigration procedures and a "Birth registration certificate" or "certification of birth registration details" for submission to the embassy. (Check with the embassy or consulate of your country to determine which document is required.) Within 30 days of birth, go to the nearest immigration office and apply for permission to obtain status of residence. Then you will go through the registration process for your child at the embassy or consulate of your country. After that, a passport can be issued. The required documents vary from country to country, so you will need to check with the embassy or consulate of your country.
- Q: I have lost my pension book. How can I get the Lump-sum withdrawal payment after returning to my country?
- A: Since pension handbooks are not distributed in the first place, you can apply for the Lump-sum withdrawal payment even after you return to your home country, using the pension number on your Basic Pension Notice. If you do not have the notification, you can contact the pension office and provide your name, address, and date of birth to request a reissue.
- Q: I will be returning to the Philippines for a week. I have been told that I need to register for eTravel, but I don't know how to do it.
- A: eTravel will be available for registration 72 hours prior to the boarding time. For this case, Plaza went through the registration process with the consulter. The same registration procedure is required for the return flight.
- eTravel is an immigration system that allows all travelers (including Filipino nationals) entering the Philippines to declare their travel information and health status online in advance. Regardless of your purpose of entry into the Philippines, whether for tourism, study or business, you are required to register for eTravel in advance.


