# PLAZA NEWSLETTER (August 2025)

Many earthquakes have been occurring around Tokara Islands, Kagoshima Prefecture every day, but recently they have also been occurring in various parts of Japan. Some of you may also have felt anxious about the disaster predictions for July. Natural disasters such as earthquakes are difficult to predict, and you never know when or where they will strike. There is a saying, "If you are prepared, you are safe", and it is

important to be prepared on a regular basis so that you can respond if something should happen. It is also a time when many disasters such as typhoons and heavy rain are expected to occur, so be sure to check evacuation sites.

Now then, allow us to partially introduce the consultation details found in our plaza. We received 63 consultations in June and have shared below examples of questions and answers. Some content has been edited for privacy concerns.

- Q: I am currently staying in Japan with the status of spouse of a permanent resident.

  My husband is quitting his job at the end of July, and he plans to go back home, but I plan to remain in Kumamoto with my child. What will happen to my health insurance?
- A: If she becomes the head of the household, she will be enrolled in National Health Insurance, so please apply for the National Health Insurance with documents showing the date of loss of Social Insurance.
- Q: I received a letter from the Japan Pension Service. I don't understand the contents.
- A: It was a notice and application form asking to join the National Pension Plan. However, he had no idea because he was already working for a company and his employee pension insurance was deducted. Plaza checked with the Japan Pension Service, which responded that he had not paid the premiums for the two weeks between his arrival in Japan and the start of his work, and that he should pay them retroactively.
- Q: I did not give birth to my child in Japan and do not have a Japanese mother-and-child notebook. Where can I get one?
- A: You can apply at your local ward office. To do so, please bring your passport or other identification and your country's Mother-and-child notebook.
- Q: I currently have the status of residence of "Engineer/Humanities/International Services" and am due to renew it in two years, but I am not sure whether I should continue to renew or change my status to "Highly Skilled Worker" which would extend my period of stay. Can you give me some advice?
- A: At the immigration consultation, we explained that technical, humanities, and international services allow change of jobs, and that if he is a highly skilled worker, his place of employment will be designated, and that in addition, in his situation, permanent residence may be considered.

## Start-up visa consultation service opened!

A consultation service has been established to assist foreigners who wish to start a business in Kumamoto City to obtain a start-up visa.

What is a start-up visa?

Foreign entrepreneurs will be granted "Designated Activities" status of residence that allows them to engage in preparatory activities for starting a business for one year (maximum two years). Kumamoto City, in cooperation with JETRO Kumamoto, has set up a specialized consultation service at XOSS POINT. to provide consultation services for foreign entrepreneurs regarding preparatory activities for starting a business.

#### Shaved Ice in Kumamoto!

Shaved ice has been recorded as being eaten since the Heian period (794–1185), and in the Pillow Book, shaved ice was eaten with amazura (syrup made from sap). At that time, ice was very precious and became a standard summer snack from the late Meiji(1868–1912) to Taisho(1912–1926) periods.

Nowadays, shaved ice comes in a variety of shapes and flavors. We will introduce some of the shaved ice available in Kumamoto!



#### Amamiya

The ice is made with subsoil water from Aso and tastes fine, fluffy and melt-in-your-mouth. A rich shaved ice topped with matcha green tea! The restaurant is also a relaxing space like a Japanese-style cafe.
