PLAZA NEWS LETTER

We had many warm days in March, and we will in April. We can go out to enjoy walking and “Hanami” (cherry blossom viewing). But, sometime, temperature goes down unexpectedly, and it rains. Please take good care of yourself. March saw the decrease in the number of coronavirus patients in Kumamoto City. However, please wear a mask when you go out and wash your hands and gargle when you get back home.

We will introduce the number of the consultations in March. The total number was 87. We had many consultations on entry procedures and residence status, job hunting, interpretation and translation, and Japanese classes. Followings are the examples:

Regarding entry procedures and residence status

- Though I will quit a university, I want to stay in Japan to do a job even after leaving the university. Is that possible? 。
- I am a technical trainee and want to stay in Japan to do a job as a specified skilled worker in the future. Can you tell me how I can do that? Can I also change my residence status from specified skilled worker to other working residence statuses?

Regarding job hunting

- I came to Kumamoto to study at a postgraduate school and want to do a part-time job. Can you help me find the job?
- I am a technical trainee and want to do a job as a specified skilled worker in the future. Can you teach me how to apply for a specified skilled worker?

Regarding interpretation and translation

- Since I do not feel well for a while, I will be seeing a doctor at a big hospital. But I cannot communicate well in Japanese. Can you provide an interpreter support?
- I am a junior high-school teacher. We have a communication problem between our student having a foreign root and his mother. We found they need an interpreter to have a meeting. Can you provide interpreter support when we have the meeting?

Regarding Japanese classes

- My husband is a foreigner who just came to Kumamoto. He cannot speak Japanese at all. Can you help us?
- I am studying Japanese by myself. But I want to hone my Japanese through conversation with Japanese people. Can you help me?

About COVID-19 related inquiries, some asked us where they can take PCR test in Kumamoto while others consulted their financial difficulties caused by the spread of the virus. If you have any problems or troubles, please contact Kumamoto Consultation and Support Plaza for Foreign Residents.

It is late March and it will be April soon. It is the beginning of new fiscal year in Japan. We call this "Shin Nendo." In Japan, the fiscal year begins on April 1st and ends on March 31st of the following year. Almost all schools and governments follow suit.

Though new year begins on January 1st, the fiscal year does on April 1st. Therefore, in March we have end of term assembly and graduation ceremony at schools and people retire from a company while we have entrance ceremony and beginning of term assembly in April. Shin Nen (New Year) and Shin Nendo (New Fiscal Year) look similar, but they differ in term they represent. Please remember that.

We enjoy Hanami or the Cherry blossom viewing from later March to April. Though many associate Hanami with cherry, it is said that Hanami custom began with plum or ume in Japanese.

Due to the warm temperatures, the cherry blossoms will bloom earlier than usual. Normally, we go out and enjoy lunch box while viewing the cherry blossoms. However, unfortunately, because of the COVID-19, it would be difficult to do that. But still we can enjoy the viewing. We would like to introduce famous places for the cherry blossom viewing in Kumamoto.

🌸 "Isshingyo no Oozakura" (3226-1 Namamatsu Aso Mura, Aso Gun, Kumamoto Prefecture)

Located in Aso, it will bloom a little bit later than Kumamoto City. Though it is one tree, its height is about 14 meters. Such a tall tree will welcome you.

🌸 "Kumamoto Castle" (1-1 Honmaru Chuo Ku, Kumamoto City)

The castle is still recovering from the damages caused by the 2016 Kumamoto earthquake. There are some areas including tenshu tower we cannot enter, but we can enjoy the cherry blossoms from surrounding area like Ninomaru Park. You can also taste Kumamoto local foods at Sakuranobaba Josaien at the foot of the castle.

Personally, I like cherry blossoms on Nagabei Street around the castle. I enjoy the viewing while commuting or during lunch time. Please check the blossoms when you come around the area.
